

Galt teen loses grocery store job

Abdel-Rehim deemed too 'slow' for Metro

CAMBRIDGE – A 16 year-old Galt resident was fired Sunday from his job at a local grocery store. Adam Abdel-Rehim had been working at the Metro on Franklin Boulevard as a cart-boy for “about a month,” he said.

Abdel-Rehim says his manager, Norma, approached him on Sunday, claiming he was not doing his job properly. “They said I was working too slow. She told me ‘you are working too slow, so you are fired,’” he said.

The Preston High School student does not agree with that

allegation, however. “She’s the only person who thinks I was working too slow,” he said.

He’s not too worried about his newfound freedom, though. “My mom told me it’s okay, so I think it’s okay,” he said.
