You may choose: The parents, authority figures, Romeo and Juliet themselves, fate, extreme emotions, or rash decision-making. Alternatively, you may ask to use another idea, but it must be approved before you begin writing.

You will need to submit the following:

- 1) A completed outline
- 2) Three handwritten or typed rough drafts with editing (see work schedule on course website)
- 3) A good copy (including Works cited page)

\*Tips: Be sure to include three (3) quotations per body paragraph. Check your final draft to ensure you have followed all MLA 7 formatting rules. Ensure that you have followed point, proof, comment, and that you have edited carefully for areas of difficulty on your *Lord of the Flies* Essay.
